## SPECIAL HORSE REGULATIONS – Ring Events

Entry Fee \$10 per horse for Show  
Ribbons awarded for 1st and 2nd only  
Prize money: 1st = \$4, 2nd = \$2

1. Competitors in Ring Events are hereby notified that they compete at their own risk and are required to sign a "Risk Warning" form (found at the back of the schedule, or at the ring side Caravan on the day of the Show.) Once the form has been received a wrist band will be allocated per competitor.

**\*\* No wrist band, no entry to classes!**

2. Local Classes eligibility: - Competitors and Mounts living within the Warren Shire - **\*\*All Members of the Warren and Nyngan Pony Clubs are eligible for local classes. (Proof required: either Pony Club membership card or Pony Club Risk Warning Form)**

3. Due to no official measuring facilities being available, competitors are responsible for having a certificate of measurement for each horse.

4. Novice Classes eligibility: - A horse/pony that has not been placed 1st in any individual open ridden hack class at any official show.

5. The Show Horse Council definition of a Show Hunter:

"These classes have been created for the horse which demonstrates a bit more substance than that which is generally seen in an Open Hack Class, but is expected to demonstrate the ability to provide a smooth, even ride and reliable temperament. The Show Hunter should exhibit sound confirmation, be free from hereditary defects and unsoundness. It should demonstrate that it is sound in wind and limb, but as it is expected to be suitable to carry its rider across country over a variety of terrain and obstacles, an honourable lump can be overlooked. The Show Hunters compete on the flat only and do not need to prove that they can jump. The workout should be similar to that expected in an Open Hack Class but should include a hand gallop and a change of leg at the canter. The horse must cover the ground in all paces, with the hand gallop being well balanced and moving from the shoulders, with the hind legs under. A flat and stilted action is unacceptable. Manners are extremely important and all misdemeanours should be penalised. Saddlery should be clean, neat and well fitting, but may be more workmanlike than normal for an Open Hack Class. Biting is optional."

6. Hunter Hacks are to be 3yrs and over.

7. Competitors must choose to compete in either the Hack Classes or the Show Hunter Classes, they cannot compete in both.

8. Competitors must choose to compete in either the ridden Adult or ridden Child Hack Classes, including Show Hunter, they cannot compete in both.

9. No persons other than the officials and press representatives will be allowed in the ring once judging has commenced. Exception: under 6yrs. rider class where assistance may be necessary.

10. No competitor will be permitted to ride outside their respective age group.

11. The Committee endeavours to programme events so clashes do not occur, but in the event of this happening Classes will not be held.

12. After a class has started a competitor will only be permitted to enter under the judge's discretion. 13. Stallions will only be allowed to compete in Ring 4 and must be handled by an adult at all times.

14. Judges decision will be final. No discussion will be entered into.

15. Horse Stalls must be booked prior to the Show at \$5 per stall per night. No booking will be accepted without total fee being paid. Refunds will only be available if booking is cancelled 3 days prior to the Show. Camping \$10 per night per campsite.

16. NO ELECTRIC FENCING IS PERMITTED ON THE SHOWGROUND!

*Every exhibitor bringing horses to the show will be required to list each horse being shown, together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) for the property from which it has come on the Waiver form before competing.*

**PROPERTY IDENTIFICATION CODES (PIC's)**

**PIC NUMBERS** – As from 1.9.2012 anybody who keeps horses in NSW will be required to obtain a PIC for land on which the horses are kept – this is a biosecurity measure. PIC's are assigned to individual properties and allocated by Local Land Services (LLS) who maintain a register. You may already have a PIC if you pay your rates to LLS.
